Read ***And Then There Were None*** by Agatha Christie. Just read it. Enjoy it. Don't take notes on it or mark it in any way. This book is a fun mystery novel and a perfect beach or poolside read. DO, however, read all of it, including the "Epilogue" and the "Manuscript."

AFTER reading the novel, select one of the characters from the novel and write 5 journal entries that character might have written **during his/her week on the island**. In the character's journal, you may reflect on events that occur prior to the start of the novel, the setting, the character's emotional/physical/psychological state, speculations about other characters, etc. The journal as a whole should communicate a clear picture of the persona narrating the entries. Each journal entry should be at least 300 words long.
