At NRCA, students are encouraged to serve as Christ would serve and to seek to be a blessing to those being served. With this mindset, their work will reflect integrity, diligence, care, and excellence for the glory of God. Our goal is from James 2:18 which says, "...I will show you my faith by my works..."

High School students in the Class of 2022, 2023, and 2024 are required to complete 12 hours of community service for each year they are enrolled. Beginning with the Class of 2025, all students will be required to complete a minimum of 25 hours of community service for each year they are enrolled. Additionally, beginning with the Class of 2025, in order to encourage service in our local community, students may only earn up to half of their community service hour requirement serving on NRCA's campus. A senior who has completed a minimum of 100 hours (Class of 2022, 2023, 2024) and 150 hours (Class of 2025 and after) prior to graduation will be honored with a silver cord at baccalaureate.

Community service must be volunteered at a school, a church, or in the community that is located within 100 miles of NRCA's campus. Community service is not (1) where the student receives remuneration of any kind, (2) self-improvement workshops or conferences, (3) rehearsal or practice time, (4) service performed as a disciplinary action, (5) service to fulfill an academic requirement, (6) babysitting for an individual family, or (7) service to family members or a business for profit.
