Details

(please read carefully before applying)

- Your student must be enrolled in one or more of the above classes **this year**. Please verify that your student is currently enrolled in the course before applying.
- You must register via the link provided below. You will be registering directly with the college.
- Dual enrollment will be open through **February 3, 2022**. After February 3, the college will begin charging a \$25 fee for any course corrections.
- To register, you will provide the student and parent contact information and student social security number.
- The fee is \$195 per course, paid via credit card. The college admissions office will not charge the credit card until the application closes in February.
- Students will receive an email confirmation which we suggest they save for future use such as ordering transcripts (more information below)
- Students should check with their teacher to learn what additional assignments they will need to complete to receive the dual enrollment credit.
- Most colleges in the U.S. will accept these credits; many accept the Bible courses as religion or elective credits. **To learn if a course transfers to a particular college and what type of credit would be received, please check the college's website or email their admissions dept.** As an example, NC State posts it [HERE](#). If you ask me about this, I will refer you to the college for the most up-to-date information.
- How is dual enrollment different from AP credit? To receive college credit for an AP course, most colleges require a score of 4 or 5 on the AP exam (sometimes a 3). Dual enrollment earns college credit (3 credit hours) for completing the course that is already being taken. A college transcript will be issued.
- If you completed a dual enrollment course in previous years and would like to order a copy of your transcript or to have it sent to a college, go here: [Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary Transcript Request | Parchment](#). **You will enter the student's social security number in place of a student ID.** Please note that transcripts will not be provided until final grades for the course have been entered. So, you will not be able to receive a transcript for a course you are taking this year until June, after final grades are posted.
